RESOLUTION NO. 22-01

RESOLUTION OF THE MARSHALL COUNTY PERSONNEL BOARD RECOMMENDING THAT THE COUNTY COMMISSION APPROVES TEMPORARY PREMIUM PAY FOR ELIGIBLE COUNTY EMPLOYEES THROUGH THE EXPENDITURE OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS.

- WHEREAS, under the provisions of Act 82-206, the Marshall County Personnel Board is empowered to govern the salaries, and benefits of the employees of Marshall County (the "County"); and
- WHEREAS, the Marshall County Commission has received American Rescue Plan Act fiscal recovery funds ("ARPA funds"); and is charged with ensuring that such funds are expended in accordance with state and federal law; and
- WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Local Fiscal Recovery Funds may be used to provide Temporary Premium Pay to eligible workers as they continue to perform essential work during the COVID-19 public health emergency; and
- WHEREAS, the Marhall County Personnel Board has determined that appropriating ARPA funds to provide premium pay to eligible County employees in response to their performing essential work during the COVID-19 pandemic is a necessary and reasonable use of these funds.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Marshall County Personnel Board hereby recommends and requests that the Marshall County Commission establish a Marshall County Temporary Premium Pay Program, from available ARPA funds, to provide temporary premium pay as additional compensation to eligible County employees.
