# <u>ENGINEERING – APPROVE ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR ENGINEERING FROM COUNTY</u> WIDE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$39,471.03

The additional charges from county wide funds will be reimbursed upon bond issuance.
