A motion was made by Vice Chairman Penni Windsor, duly seconded by Board Member Michael Clay. Chairman Charles Whisenant then asked if there was any further discussion; Vice Chairman Penni Windsor asked that the board go ahead and instruct the Personnel Administrator to reach out to the County Commission Association, County Risk Services and the Dept of Public Examiners regarding the letter and hiring procedures.
